The Schools Craft Competition, run in conjunction with Glasgow City Council Education Services, has already been judged. It recognises and rewards traditional craft work undertaken by pupils as part of the SQA Standard and Higher Grade Craft and Design syllabuses. Approximately two hundred and fifty pupils from fifteen to twenty secondary schools within Glasgow participate each year. The overall winner will be chosen on Thursday 8th June at 2.30pm.
