*About the Charity: **Kinship Care Initiative***

The Trades House of Glasgow is a registered charity concentrating on the poor and disadvantaged in Glasgow.

In 2015 it launched an ambitious appeal to raise money for children and young people in Kinship Care. Glasgow City Council is responsible for over 1200 such young people. There may be an equal number in informal placement with kinship carers. Kinship Care describes when family members or friends, take long term or permanent care of children who are unable to live with their parents. This is usually because of reasons such as drug and alcohol addiction, domestic violence, neglect and mental health problems. Most children in Kinship Care have suffered serious adversities and trauma. A high proportion live in poverty.

We want to help create a change in this area and break the negative cycle, by providing opportunities that will nurture talent, develop skills, and build confidence, character and self-esteem.
